Act-Belong-Commit Campaign National Partnership Framework

DEFINITIONS:

State Steering Committee – A group of key stakeholders that provide support, links and expertise to guide the strategic direction of the campaign.

Mentally Healthy WA – The operational ‘Hub’ that coordinates the Act-Belong-Commit Campaign on a state-wide level in WA.

National Partner – An organisation that is partnered with Mentally Healthy WA and promotes the Act-Belong-Commit Campaign on a National level.

State Partner – An organisation from another State within Australia that implements the Act-Belong-Commit Campaign on a state level. They operate similarly to the Mentally Healthy WA Hub in Western Australia.

Healthway Sponsored Organisation – An organisation that has received Healthway Sponsorship to host an arts or sport event and is assigned a health message (in this case the *Act-Belong-Commit* message) to promote through the sponsored activity or event.

Collaborating Partner – Usually a state-wide organisation that has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Mentally Healthy WA to work collaboratively to develop joint resources or actively promote each others’ philosophies and services to the community.

Act-Belong-Commit ‘Site’ – An organisation (e.g. local government, health service) that has signed a Local Service Agreement to operate the Act-Belong-Commit campaign on a local level. The main ‘site’ contact is referred to as an Act-Belong-Commit Project Officer.

Community Partner – A community group or club that wishes to promote the Act-Belong-Commit message but resides in an area not serviced by a local Act-Belong-Commit Project Officer. The group signs a Community Partner Agreement directly with Mentally Healthy WA and agrees to promote the message to club participants, members, volunteers and at wider community activities.
